This will include provision of competent teachers, a full and balanced curriculum, regular reporting, and adequate supervision of the children during school hours.

  - B. To meet financial obligations to the school promptly,
  - C. To attend Parent/Teacher conferences, to support the school and keep informed about activities and needs.
