The PSAT (practice SAT) will be held at SRCS on Wednesday, October 14th at 8:30am. This is for all sophomores and juniors. Please bring two number 2 pencils. You may also bring an approved calculator (please check www.collegeboard.com for a list of approved and prohibited calculators).

The PSAT offers opportunities for high scorers to be in the National Merit Scholarship program. There are practice tests and information about the PSAT outside the upstairs office. The PSAT costs \$13 per student and will be included on the tuition statement.

12th Grade Students and Parents:

The SAT is on October 10th. The ACT is on October 24th. You must register by September 18th. Make sure to indicate that you are taking the ACT plus Writing. The ACT is administered right here on our campus. SRCS school test center code is: 222700.

For college consideration, you must take these tests before December. Please register online at: www.collegeboard.com and www.act.org. Stop by Mrs. Dibley's office to let her know if you have signed up for either of these.
