Registration Information for New Students

The application packet for the 2010-2011 school year is attached. Please note the following items which are necessary for your application to be processed. Please contact our office should any questions arise. Thank you

- Birth Certificates** Students entering kindergarten at Santa Rosa Christian School should be 5 years old by September 1. By law, we must verify each student’s name, birth date, and place of birth, as shown on the birth certificate, when a child enters kindergarten. Bring a certified copy of your child’s birth certificate with your application papers. In addition, we do require a copy be on file for every student attending Santa Rosa Christian School.
- Immunizations** **Proof of immunizations must be submitted with your student’s application.** All students must be current on all required immunizations prior to the first day of school. **Please note that there are new varicella (chickenpox) immunization requirements for students who are entering kindergarten.**
- Physical Exams** The State Department of Health requires that **all students entering first grade** must have had a physical examination by a physician within the 18 months prior to first grade. The Physician’s Report must be on file in the school office with the student’s records. The Physician’s report is available through our office, or your physician’s office may have a standard form which they use.
- Student Names** As required by law, all official school records must be maintained under a student’s birth name unless that name has been legally changed. Documentation of the legal name change must accompany the application.
- Application Fee** \$50 per Student The new student Application Fee covers costs of processing the application, interviews, and student placement testing. This is a one-time-only **non-refundable** fee.
- Registration Fee** \$245 per Student The annual registration fee covers the cost of processing the enrollment. This financial commitment on the part of families allows the administration to project enrollment, staffing and curriculum needs more accurately. **The registration fee is non-refundable.** For new families the first month’s tuition payment is due with the registration fee.

The faculty and staff at Santa Rosa Christian School are dedicated to providing an excellent academic education and to helping each child achieve his or her best through our educational programs. To accomplish our goals the following enrollment policies are in place:

- Parents of Santa Rosa Christian School students agree to support SRCS’s guidelines and curriculum and to work in harmony with the school, its policies and practices.
- Santa Rosa Christian School admits both Christian and non-Christian students with **teachable hearts** and **coachable spirits**. We welcome students who desire an excellent education and are willing to learn within our Christian worldview. If at any time our faculty or staff becomes aware that a student is mocking our Christian faith or disrespectful toward our Christian Worldview, that student may be expelled from the school.
- We strive to maintain high academic standards at Santa Rosa Christian School. We believe that all students accepted at SRCS are able to perform at high levels of achievement through attentive learning in the class and faithful study practices. To support this belief parents will work in tandem with the school to ensure their student’s academic success.
- Students determined to have attitudinal, behavioral, or spiritual problems will likely experience concurrent educational deficiencies. In our efforts to teach successful students, Santa Rosa Christian School may require family and/or student counseling should continued enrollment be desired.
- Parents at SRCS are expected to contribute family service hours in support of SRCS.

This will include the provision of competent teachers, a full and balanced curriculum, regular reporting, and adequate supervision of children during school hours.

5. We pledge the following as a condition of our child’s enrollment in Santa Rosa Christian School:
 - A. to support the school and help our child meet homework requirements
 - B. to meet financial obligations to the school promptly
 - C. to attend Parent/Teacher conferences, and keep informed about school activities and other school needs
 - D. to make gifts and pledges, as the Lord enables us (gifts and donations are tax-deductible, tuition is not)
 - E. to volunteer at the school
